PRESCHOOL

Our preschoolers have a lot to celebrate in February and that leads to many interesting activities. The month begins with the Chinese New Year and Ground Hog day. It is Dental Health month, Black History month, and Abraham Lincoln and George Washington's birthdays. And yes, it's Valentine's Day!

In blocks, we'll build the Great Wall of China in honor of the Chinese New Year, set out the Lincoln logs and craft sticks to encourage log cabin building, and build a tunnel for a ground hog. In honor of George Washington, we'll build the Washington Monument – and measure it, of course!

In our math center, we'll label baby food jars 1 – 10 and have the children put the correct number of pennies in each jar.

In language, our preschoolers will talk about dental health and healthy foods. We'll make a good health chart and cut out pictures of healthy food. We'll sponge paint the letter "t" for tooth and "v" for valentine.

Dramatic play is so much fun when there are so many different events in the month. We'll set up a post office for our valentines and a florist shop.

In science, we'll make our own toothpaste with baking soda and salt. We'll drop an egg in iced tea and then brush it with toothpaste until the stain disappears (teeth and egg shells are both made of calcium).

INFANTS & TODDLERS

Everything a young child knows about the world is learned through one of the five senses. This month our infants and toddlers will be exploring *seeing, touching, hearing, tasting and smelling*. They will look at different shapes, sizes, and colors. By touching, infants and toddlers learn about the world through their fingers and toes.

Our children will have the opportunity to sense cool and warm, soft and hard, smooth and bumpy, wet and dry, even before they can speak the words. They will learn that the ear is the organ through which they hear sounds. They'll learn shake, jingle, boom, bump and clap.
